## ***AHEPA Mount-Royal Chapter Scholarship for Academic Achievement***

*This scholarship is open to any student of Greek origin (from either paternal or maternal line) enrolled in a full-time programme of undergraduate or graduate level study for the academic year 2009-2010 at any Quebec based accredited university institution. To qualify a student should have completed at least one year of university study and be a resident of Quebec.*

To be considered the applicant must submit the following documents:

1. Scholarship application form (attached below)
2. A copy of your curriculum vitae
3. Proof of full-time enrollment in a Quebec university for the academic year 2009-2010
4. Official academic transcripts (Graduate students should provide both undergraduate and graduate transcripts)
5. A 300-word typed personal statement (in English, French or Greek) outlining the applicant's personal goals, career objectives and the role that your Greek heritage has played in your upbringing and your future plans in life.
6. Two (2) letters of reference, at least one of which should be written by a professor acquainted with the applicant's academic performance. These letters should be sent to the address of AHEPA directly by the signatories or by enclosed in a sealed envelope signed by them in the back of the envelope.
7. A "3" by "3" headshot photo of yourself.

Note: Past AHEPA scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply for another scholarship unless they have since changed their program or moved to a higher cycle of study. Although a student may apply for both scholarships offered by AHEPA Montreal they will only be awarded one of the two. To be considered, an applicant must have at least a 3.2 GPA or equivalent.

## ***AHEPA Hellenic Studies Scholarship for Academic Achievement***

*This scholarship is open to any student of Greek origin (from either paternal or maternal line) enrolled in a full-time programme of undergraduate or graduate level study for the academic year 2009-2010 at **Concordia University** and who has successfully completed at least nine (9) credits (three courses) in any aspect of Hellenic Studies, (Classics, Byzantine or Neo-Hellenic). To qualify a student should have completed at least one year of university study and be a resident of Quebec.*
